## **CAR PARKING**

Car parking at the event is strictly limited due to space, and the AGPC allocates a limited number of car parking passes to race officials for the Village Green car park. Due to the limitations we encourage officials to use public transport or carpool.

Preference is given to those who carpool with other officials, so for the best chance of obtaining a pass please list your passengers in the space provided on the attached form. You will be able to collect your pass with your uniform and credentials at the circuit.

## DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

At the AGP, some meal alternatives are offered for those with specific dietary requirements. If you require a Gluten Free or Vegetarian lunch at the 2011 event and did not indicate this on your initial application, please contact us (1300 883 959) to ensure you are placed on the list for one of these lunches.

## EMERGENCY CONTACTS

CAMS requires an emergency contact to be listed for every official (although we hope we never have to use them!). Please ensure your Emergency Contact details are up-to-date by informing us of any changes.



## OFFICIALS LICENCES

Now is the time to check your CAMS Official's Licence! If your licence has expired or you do not have one, you can obtain a licence form from the CAMS [website](#) or calling CAMS on 1300 883 959.

If you need to renew your licence, select "Renewal Form" under "Existing Officials", complete the relevant sections and return to CAMS Customer Service as per instructions on the form.

If you have never held a CAMS Licence before, select "Trainee Licence Application Form". You must complete all sections of the form, except for Section 2. Then bring your form to any motor sport event you officiate at and your supervising official can sign off on your motor sport officiating activity. After the event, you can submit your completed form to CAMS, who will then contact you asking you to complete an Introductory Module before processing and issuing your General Officials Licence.

You must have a current CAMS Officials Licence to be covered by CAMS insurances when officiating at any CAMS motor sport event, including the AGP.
