INFORMATION FOR NEW OFFICIALS

If you are new to officiating at the Australian Grand Prix, you can also refer to the Information for New Officials document which provides some extra information for those who have not volunteered at Albert Park before.

CREDENTIAL PHOTOS

To gain access to the circuit, all officials are issued with a photo ID credential.

RETURNING officials do not need to submit another photo unless you would like an updated one on your credential.

If you are a NEW AGP Official, or you would like a new photo on your credential, you will need to supply us with one. **Please ensure you have supplied your photo to us by Friday 25th February 2011 to ensure your credential will be ready for collection.**

It is best if your photo is taken against a light coloured background (e.g. white wall).

CAR PARKING

In the last newsletter we included a form for applying for a car pass to park at the Village Green Car Park, near Gate 10. If you require a pass but have not yet applied for one, you will now need to contact us at the CAMS office as remaining places are very limited.

Everyone who has applied for a car park so far has been allocated a pass. This will be confirmed in your final newsletter which will also contain your credentials collection paperwork.

UNIFORMS

If you have kept your uniform since last year it is assumed that it fits and will be suitable for wear in the 2011 event (unless you have specified otherwise in your application). All puitsuits must be returned to the Muster Tent on the Sunday night at the end of the event.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

At the AGP, some meal alternatives are offered for those with specific dietary requirements. If you require a Gluten Free or Vegetarian lunch at the 2011 event and did not indicate this on your initial application, please contact us (1300 883 959) to ensure you are placed on the list for one of these lunches.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS

CAMS requires an emergency contact to be listed for every official (although we hope we never have to use them!). Please ensure your Emergency Contact details are up-to-date by informing us of any changes.

TRACK ALLOCATIONS

For those trackside officials, we are still finalising track allocations however these will be sent to you with your final newsletter.



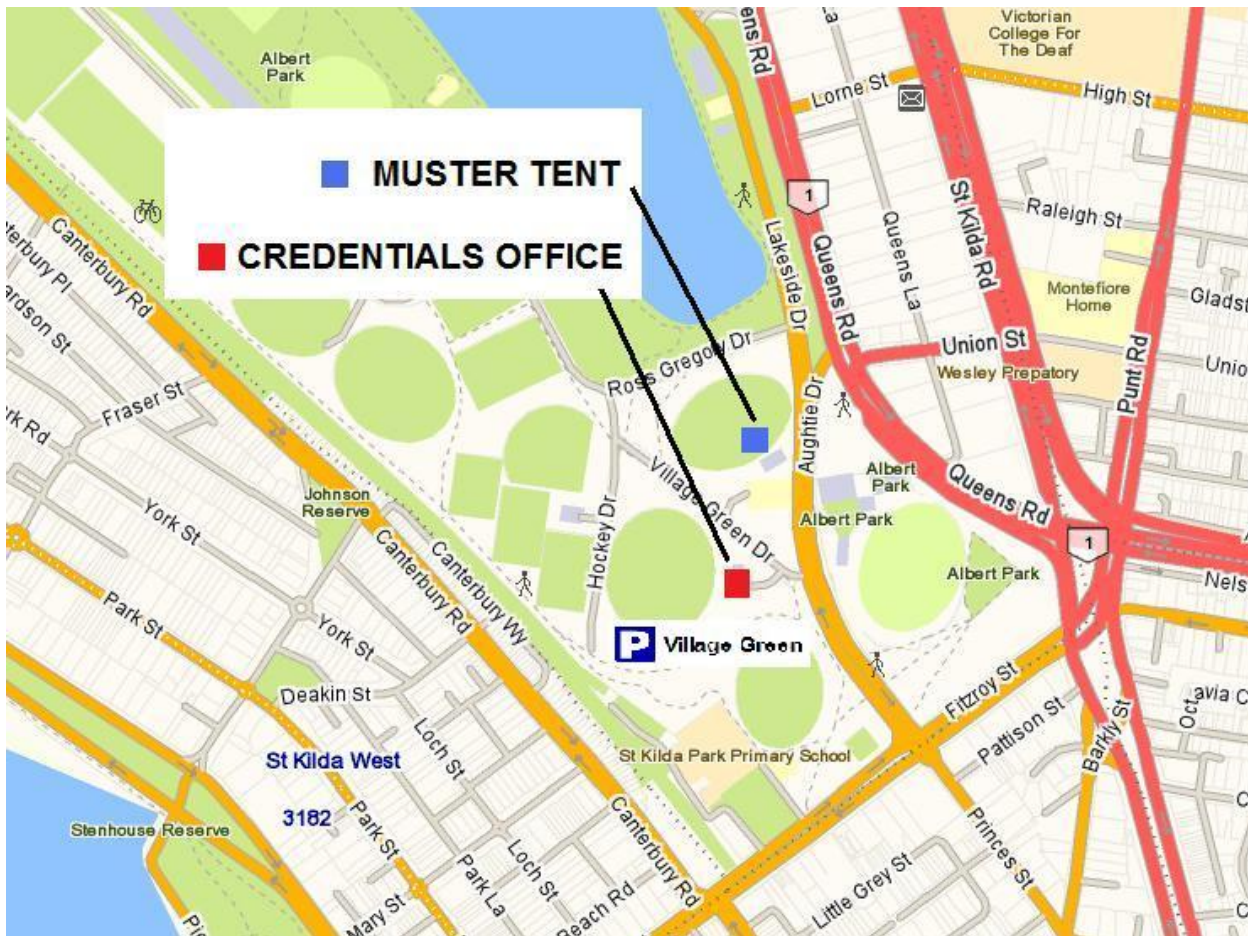
CREDENTIALS OFFICE – LOCATION & OPENING TIMES

Please note a **change to the Credentials Office Location** for 2011 – you will no longer need to go to the Bowls Club/Gate 1 to collect your credentials!

This year credentials and uniforms will be collected from the Credentials Office at the **Holdsworth Pavilion**, near the Gate 10 entrance and adjacent to the Village Green Car Park. **You do not need to go to the Bowls Club or Gate 1**. You will need to enter the circuit via Fitzroy Street and follow the road around to the left, until you see signage for the Credentials Office. This office will only be looking after Race Officials and Support Category Credentials. You will be able to park outside the Credentials Office (pre-event days only) for a short time to collect your credentials.

The next and final Newscast will contain your Credential Collection Information.

The map below shows the new location of the Credentials Office and the new Muster Tent location.

GUEST PASSES

When you collect your credentials you will also receive 2 Guest Passes for your friends or family to attend the event. These are for all four days and one of these also admits to the Officials' post-race BBQ on the Sunday night.



OFFICIALS LICENCES

Now is the time to check your CAMS Official's Licence! If your licence has expired or you do not have one, you can obtain a licence form from the CAMS [website](#) or calling CAMS on 1300 883 959.

If you need to renew your licence, select "Renewal Form" under "Existing Officials", complete the relevant sections and return to CAMS Customer Service as per instructions on the form.

You must have a current CAMS Officials Licence to be covered by CAMS insurances when officiating at any CAMS motor sport event, including the AGP.

OFFICIALS LICENCES FOR NEW / INTERNATIONAL OFFICIALS

New and international officials can operate on a CAMS Trainee Licence. To do this you can download the CAMS Trainee Licence Application Form from the CAMS website or you can request a form from the CAMS office.

You will then need to fill in your details and ensure you sign the declaration. **Keep the form with you and take with you to the AGP** – this will become your Trainee Licence at the event. During the event, make sure you have your motor sport officiating activity signed off on the form in the space provided, by your supervising official. After the event, you can then send your completed form to CAMS. You will then be sent the Introductory Module by email which you can complete online to obtain your CAMS General Officials Licence. Music

The Australian Grand Prix Corporation has announced that the Sunday night concert headline act will be Aussie band The Living End. From www.grandprix.com.au:

Sunday night will see The Living End thrill audiences as thousands flock from all corners of the Albert Park circuit to see local Melbourne boys Chris, Andy and Scott deliver an electrifying free post-race performance open to all ticket holders following the podium presentation.

The legendary trio will delight Grand Prix fans with their renowned rock performance in an increasingly rare Australian appearance, now that Chris Cheney is relocating to LA.

"We can't wait to be part of the festival action in front of our home crowd. We'll be there with the fans cheering on Aussie champ, Mark Webber," said lead singer Chris Cheney. With a long list of Australian music accolades under their belt including ARIA, APRA and Jack awards, fans are eagerly awaiting The Living End's sixth album due for release mid-year, so the band is sure to rock the GP crowd with some highly anticipated new material. All ticket holders will be able to attend the concert!

Support Categories and On-Track Entertainment

The V8 Supercars will again appear with a new race format for 2011. The V8s will battle in two 150km races and one 100km race over the weekend being dubbed the V8 Supercars Albert Park 400. They will be joined by the Porsche Carrera Cup, return to Albert Park for the first time since 2008 for round one of their 2011 championship. The Shannons Historic Demonstration will also be back as will the Ultimate Speed Comparison, pitting a Formula 1 car against a road car and a race car.

Another spectacle on the track will see former F1 driver David Coulthard, Toro Rosso practice and third driver, West Australian Daniel Ricardo, V8 Supercar driver Rick Kelly and motorcycle daredevil Robbie Maddison go head to head in the Red Bull Race Off. Renault Australia will be providing four Megane Renault Sport 250s with safety modifications including a six point full safety cage. The Red Bull Race Off is sure to be one of the highlights of the weekend so keep an eye out in the program for it!

2011 will also see the return of the celebrity race, with the Lexus CT 200h Celebrity Challenge. This will feature 27 all-new Lexus CT200h hybrid vehicles raced around Albert Park, and will be the first globally staged hybrid-only race. Stay tuned for news on which celebrities will be getting behind the wheel!
