SPORTING REGULATIONS AMENDMENT 4****REFERENCE:**

**RATIONALE:**

*To alter the Sporting Regulations to reflect the cancellation of the Coffs Harbour round of the Championship and to address sporting issues arising as a result of the reduction in the number of rounds.*

**ACTION:**

*Amend 2009 CAMS Online Manual of Motor Sport, Sporting Regulations, 2009 Australian Rally Championship Sporting Regulations as follows:*

**3. CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE**

The 2009 Australian Rally Championship Super Series will be conducted over the following events:

**19.3.1 Privateers' Cup:**

(iii) Awards will be based on points 40, 34, 30, 26, 22, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 for places first to twentieth amongst all eligible vehicles in each Heat (i.e., places gained by non-eligible vehicles will be disregarded). Only the best **3 4** events will be counted in determining the winners.

**19.3.2 Showroom Series:**

(iii) Awards will be based on points 40, 34, 30, 26, 22, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 for places first to twentieth amongst all eligible vehicles in each Heat (i.e., places gained by non-eligible vehicles will be disregarded). Only the best **3 4** events will be counted in determining the winners.

**19.3.3 Eco Rally Challenge:**

(iii) The award will be based on points 40, 34, 30, 26, 22, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 for places first to twentieth amongst all eligible vehicles in each Heat (i.e., places gained by non-eligible vehicles will be disregarded). Only the best ~~3~~ **4** events will be counted in determining the winners.

**19.4 Australian Rally Manufacturers' Championship**

(i) The Australian Rally Manufacturers' Championship will comprise all of the events in the ARC Super Series including Rally Queensland and Rally Australia. Only the results from the best ~~5~~ **6** events scored by each registered manufacturer will be counted in determining the winners of the Championship.

**19.5 Class Awards:**

Points shall be awarded to the first 20 drivers and co-drivers of 40, 34, 30, 26, 22, 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 respectively. Only the best ~~8~~ **10** heats will be counted in determining the winners.
