**RATIONALE:**

*To amend the 2009 Australian Mini Challenge Series Sporting & Technical Regulations and Commercial Arrangements.*

**ACTION:**

*Amend the 2009 Australian Mini Challenge Series Sporting Regulations as follows:*

**S5 DRIVER ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible to compete in the Series, a Driver must hold a current CAMS Provisional Circuit Licence or higher and be registered for the Series with the CM. A CAMS National Circuit Licence is required for certain events (e.g. Mt Panorama – Bathurst) and this requirement shall be advised in Event Supplementary Regulations.

**S5.1 Substitute Drivers**

Prior to the commencement of the first practice session at each round of the Series, a Competitor may nominate a substitute driver who may be permitted to compete in the remainder of the meeting subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting and the CM.

**S5.2 Guest Drivers**

**The CM may nominate a guest driver/s for each round of the Series. Guest drivers may not register for the Series and will not be considered in the results of any round when Series points are being allocated.**

*Amend the 2009 Australian Mini Challenge Series Technical Regulations as follows:*

**T2 ELIGIBILITY**

...

**T2.2.3** The weight is established on the weighing device binding for the MINI CHALLENGE or on a calibrated weighing device provided on-site. ~~A tolerance of 8 kg is permitted for the weighing result established on the MINI CHALLENGE weighing device.~~

**T2.2.4** ~~The applicable~~ **A** tolerance will be considered if another weighing device is used. The weighing result is final.
