FIA GROUP N – SPECIFIC REGULATIONS FOR PRODUCTION CARS

RATIONALE:

To provide a further extension until 31 December 2010 to Group N and Group N (P) for the use of linear bearings in suspension components for events of national status and below.

ACTION:

Amend the note as found on the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport under Rally Road:

• FIA Group N – Specific Regulations for Production Cars

Specific Regulations for Production Cars (Group N) (FIA Appendix J, Article 254) are available from the FIA website, www.fia.com

ARCom has granted an exemption to Group N and Group N(P) rally cars which are subject of a CAMS log book issued prior to 31 December 2007, from the following requirements of FIA Article 254 – Specific Regulations for Production Cars, Group N, Article 8, Rule 6.3, Suspension: "The use of bearings with linear guidance is prohibited. Only guidance by plain bearings is authorised." This exemption applies only to events of national status and below and expires 31 December 200910.
